- 2) The Student is a resident of Torrington, Winsted, New Hartford, Barkhamsted, Norfolk, Colebrook, Harwinton or Goshen or is a direct relative of an active Torrington/Winsted Rotary member.
- 3) The Student demonstrates financial need;
- 4) The Student demonstrates academic achievement,
- 5) The Student demonstrates the characteristics of good citizenship
